Project Description



- The projects purpose is to reinstate environmental flows to Mulcra Island allowing both dry and wet periods through a series of regulating structures.
- Due to the projects location within the Murray-Sunset National Park special environmental and cultural heritage considerations were an integral aspect of the project.
- During the River Murray floods of 2011 the Lower Potterwalkagee Regulator failed due to piping failure and repair works were required to remediate the problem.
- The main scope of works comprises of clay core installation, chimney & transition filters, scour protection, concrete works and stop log installation.

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
